

OKLAHOMA ACCOUNTANCY BOARD**MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING**

February 21, 2020

The Oklahoma Accountancy Board (OAB) convened in regular session on Friday, February 21, 2020, at Oklahoma Accountancy Board, 201 NW 63rd St; Ste. 210, Oklahoma City, OK 73116. A recording of the meeting is on file in the OAB office. Members present at Call to Order:

Agenda Item #1a – Call To Order: At approximately 8:32 AM, Chair Vernon called the meeting to order.

Agenda Item #1b – Declaration of Quorum: Chair Vernon declared a quorum.

Agenda Item #1c – Announcement of Legal Meeting Notice: Executive Director Ross confirmed the notice of the meeting was filed with the Secretary of State and the agenda for the meeting was properly posted in compliance with the Open Meeting Act.

Agenda Item #1d – Announcement of Absences and Action, if Necessary, to Determine Whether Absence(s) Were Unavoidable Pursuant to Title 59, Section 15.3(B)(5): There were no absences.

Agenda Item #2 – Announcement of Visitors: The following visitors were present for the appropriate time: Blaine Peterson and Steve Milam, representing the OSCPA; Dean Taylor, representing the OSA; Jay States, Respondent; J.D. White, counsel for Respondent; Randy Calvert, Calvert Law Firm; John Martin, court reporter; Paul Garcia, Jr., criminal history review applicant; and Eulean Hollis, criminal history review applicant.

Agenda Item #3 – Public Comment Period: Executive Director Ross advised the Board that he had not received any requests for public comment.

Agenda Item #4 – Consent Agenda: The Consent Agenda contained five items for the OAB's consideration: (1) Approve the Minutes of the December 20, 2019, Regular Meeting of the OAB; (2) Take official notice of the preliminary OAB financial statements for the months ending December 31, 2019, and January 31, 2020; (3) Take official

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notice of the experience verification applications which have been approved by the Executive Director; (4) Approve the actions taken by the Executive Director on applications and registrations filed since the previous meeting; and (5) Approve the verification of the administrative posting to the OAB's records and certification of scores for Window 4/2019 Examination, October, November, and December 2019.

Motion by Manning that the Board approve the Consent Agenda with corrections to Minutes. Second by Greenwell.

Affirmative Votes: Taylor, Sanner, Greenwell, Manning, Byford and Vernon.

Agenda Item #5 – Discussion and possible action on Administrative Actions and report from the Enforcement Committee:

ADMINISTRATIVE CONSENT ORDERS:

Case No. 2236 – Ursula Lundberg, CPA

This case was opened as a result of a referral by the CPE Coordinator that Respondent was one hour short of meeting the four-hour minimum ethics CPE requirement for compliance period 2016-2018. An Administrative Consent Order was offered by the Enforcement Committee and accepted by the Respondent whereby Respondent is assessed a fine of \$500, plus costs and attorney fees in the amount of \$259.30, which must be paid within 30 days of the effective date of the order. Respondent has submitted an hour of ethics CPE to apply to the shortage. A proven violation of this ACO, the Act or the Board's Rules authorizes the Board to take such other and further action as the Board may deem appropriate under the Act. The Enforcement Committee recommends the Administrative Consent Order in this case be approved by the Board.

OAB Records Summary

CPE Status: Registrant is now in compliance. Registrant reported 78 hours for 2016 (includes 1 hour ethics); 47 hours for 2017 (includes 1 hours ethics); and 44.5 hours for 2018 (includes 2 hours ethics after adjustment).

Peer Review Status: N/A.

Motion by Taylor that the Board approve the Administrative Consent Orders in Case no. 2236. Second by Greenwell.

Affirmative Votes: Taylor, Sanner, Greenwell, Manning, Byford and Vernon.

FILES TO CLOSE:

File No. 2309 – CPA

This file is the result of a complaint alleging fraudulent activity by the registrant nearly twenty years ago. The Enforcement Committee did not find sufficient evidence of a violation of the Act or Board's Rules; therefore it recommends that the file be closed.

OAB Records Summary

CPE Status: Registrant is in compliance. Registrant reported 44 hours for 2016 (includes 0 hours ethics); 44 hours for 2017 (includes 4 hours ethics); and 45 hours for 2018 (includes 4 hours ethics).

Peer Review Status: N/A.

File No. 2514 – CPA

This file is the result of a referral from the Department of Labor informing the Board that the registrant's non-accounting related business violated the Fair Labor Standards Act by underpaying an employee. Because the business is not accounting-related and the sanctions to that business seem appropriate without further discipline to the registrant, the Enforcement Committee recommends that the file be closed.

OAB Records Summary

CPE Status: Registrant is in compliance. Registrant reported 44 hours for 2016 (includes 4 hours ethics); 43 hours for 2017 (includes 0 hours ethics); and 44 hours for 2018 (includes 4 hours ethics).

Peer Review Status: N/A.

File No. 2511 – CPA

This file is a result of a complaint alleging misconduct and substandard work by the registrant with regard to work with a non-profit entity. The Enforcement Committee did not find sufficient evidence of a violation of the Act or Board's Rules; therefore it recommends that the file be closed.

OAB Records Summary

CPE Status: Registrant is in compliance. Registrant reported 40.5 hours for 2016 (includes 3.5 hours ethics); 43 hours for 2017 (includes 2.5 hours ethics); and 38.5 hours for 2018 (includes 1 hour ethics).

Peer Review Status: N/A.

File No. 2512 – CPA

This file is a result of a complaint alleging misconduct and substandard work by the registrant with regard to work with a non-profit entity. The Enforcement Committee did not find sufficient evidence of a violation of the Act or Board's Rules; therefore it recommends that the file be closed.

OAB Records Summary

CPE Status: Registrant is in compliance. Registrant reported 42.5 hours for 2016 (includes 2 hours ethics); 44 hours for 2017 (includes 2 hours ethics); and 48 hours for 2018 (includes 8 hours ethics).

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Peer Review Status: N/A.

File No. 2518 – CPA

This file is the result of a referral from the CPE Coordinator that the registrant was 2 hours short of the 4-hour minimum ethics CPE requirement for compliance period 2016-2018. The registrant submitted documentation of a major medical issue at the end of 2018; therefore the Enforcement Committee recommends that the registrant be allowed to apply hours back to the shortage and that the file be closed.

OAB Records Summary

CPE Status: Registrant is not in compliance. Registrant reported 52 hours for 2016 (includes 0 hours ethics); 48 hours for 2017 (includes 0 hours ethics); and 30 hours for 2018 (includes 2 hours ethics).

Peer Review Status: N/A.

File No. 2522 – CPA

This file was opened as a result of the registrant being 7.5 hour short of the 120-hour minimum CPE requirement for 2016-2018. The registrant misreported hours and has submitted sufficient documentation to bring the period back into compliance. The Enforcement Committee recommends that the file be closed.

OAB Records Summary

CPE Status: Registrant is now compliance after adjustment. Registrant reported 47 hours for 2016 (includes 0 hours ethics); 40 hours for 2017 (includes 4 hours ethics); and 39 hours for 2018 (includes 4 hours ethics).

Peer Review Status: N/A.

Motion by Taylor that the Board close File no.'s 2309, 2514, 2511, 2512, 2518 and 2522. Second by Greenwell.

Affirmative Votes: Taylor, Sanner, Greenwell, Manning, Byford and Vernon.

Agenda Item #8 – Discussion and possible action on the American Institute of Certified Public Accountant's request for comments on its practice analysis and CPA evolution timeline: A discussion took place among the Board. Vice Chair Taylor

suggested that the Board take more time to prepare a response and revisit this item at the April Board meeting.

Note: Chair Vernon called for a break at approximately 8:59 AM and reconvened at 9:03 AM.

Hearing

Case No. 2237 – Hearing in the matter of the Application to Reinstate the Certificate of Jay Alan States: This case came for hearing at 9:03 AM. The members of the Oklahoma Accountancy Board present were seated on the hearing panel.

Assistant Attorney General John Crittenden advised the Board. Special Prosecutor Randy Calvert represented the State. Respondent was present and was represented by counsel, J.D. White.

The purpose of this hearing was to determine whether the Respondent's application for reinstatement should be approved.

The counsel for the Respondent submitted Exhibit 1 to the Board. There were no objections. At the recommendation of Assistant Attorney General Crittenden, Chair Vernon accepted Exhibit 1 into the record.

The counsel for the Respondent gave his opening statement. Special Prosecutor Calvert did not have an opening statement.

The counsel for the Respondent presented his case.

Special Prosecutor Calvert called the Respondent and questioned him on his past and current conduct.

Special Prosecutor Calvert moved for the admission of the State's Exhibits 2-12. There were no objections. At the recommendation of the Assistant Attorney General Crittenden, Chair Vernon accepted the Exhibits into the record.

Board members questioned the Respondent on his past and current conduct.

Both Special Prosecutor Calvert and the counsel for the Respondent gave closing statements.

At this time Chair Vernon entertained a motion to enter Executive Session.

Motion by Sanner that the Board enter into Executive Session. Second by Greenwell.

Affirmative Votes: Taylor, Sanner, Greenwell, Manning, Byford and Vernon.

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The Board entered into Executive Session at approximately 10:25 AM.

Motion by Manning that the Board come out of Executive Session. Second by Greenwell.

Affirmative Votes: Taylor, Sanner, Greenwell, Manning, Byford and Vernon.

The Board came out of Executive Session at approximately 11:08 AM.

During the Executive Session no votes were taken and no other matters were discussed.

Motion by Sanner in Case No. 2237 that the Board reinstate the certificate of Jay Alan States. Second by Manning.
