INDICTMENT

FOR: MURDER IN THE FIRST DEGREE, Title 21 O.S. § 701.7, [COUNT 1]

DESECRATION OF A HUMAN CORPSE Title 21 O.S. § 1161.1, [COUNT 2]

CONSPIRACY TO COMMIT A FELONY Title 21 O.S. § 421, [COUNT 3]

IN THE NAME AND BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

By the order of the Supreme Court of Oklahoma, the Fifteenth Multicounty Grand Jury was convened with its principal site to be in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma County, Oklahoma, to serve from February February 17, 2015 until August 25, 2016, or until the designated presiding judge determines the Fifteenth Multicounty Grand Jury has reached reasonable completion of its investigations, but, in any event, no more than twenty-four (24) months from the commencement of its term. That the said Multicounty Grand Jury of the State of Oklahoma, being composed of good and lawful men and women, legally drawn and summoned according to law, and then and there examined, impaneled, sworn and charged according to law to diligently inquire into and true presentment make of all public offenses against the State of Oklahoma committed and

triable within the State of Oklahoma, upon their oath and in the name and by the authority of the State of Oklahoma, do present and find that:

COUNT 1: MURDER IN THE FIRST DEGREE ~ a FELONY,

On or about the 7th day of August, 2012, the crime of **MURDER IN THE FIRST DEGREE**, a felony, was committed in **GARVIN COUNTY, OKLAHOMA**, by the defendant, **AMBER MARIE ANDREWS**, who, acting conjointly with **JUSTIN HAMMER**, deliberately, intentionally, with malice aforethought, and without authority of law, take away the life of Brandon Mark Duran, a human being, by shooting him with a projectile fired from a twenty-two caliber handgun and a .410 shotgun, which then and there inflicted certain mortal wounds from which the same Brandon Mark Duran did languish and die, being committed contrary to the provisions of Section 701.7 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

COUNT 2: DESECRATION OF A HUMAN CORPSE ~ a FELONY,

On or about the 7th day of August, 2012, the crime of **DESECRATION OF A HUMAN CORPSE**, a felony, was committed in **GARVIN COUNTY, OKLAHOMA**, by the defendant, **AMBER MARIE ANDREWS**, who, acting conjointly with **JUSTIN HAMMER**, knowingly and willfully, dismembered the body of Brandon Mark Duran, a human being, by cutting his body into pieces, for the purpose of tampering with evidence of a crime and disposing of a dead body, being committed contrary to the provisions of Section 1161.1 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.


COUNT 3: CONSPIRACY ~ a FELONY,

On or about the 1st day of August through 7th day of August, 2012, the crime of **CONSPIRACY TO COMMIT A FELONY**, a felony, was committed in **GARVIN COUNTY,**

OKLAHOMA, by the defendant, AMBER MARIE ANDREWS, who, acting conjointly with JUSTIN HAMMER, Conspired to commit the crime of Murder in the First Degree and Desecration of a Human Corpse by causing the death of Brandon Mark Duran by shooting him in the head, and causing him to die, and dismembering his body to prohibit the detection of a crime, being committed contrary to the provisions of Section 421 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

Penalties:

COUNT 1: This crime is punishable by death, imprisonment for life without parole, or by imprisonment for life.

COUNT 2: This crime is punishable by imprisonment in the custody of the Department of Corrections for a term not more than seven (7) years, by a fine not exceeding Eight Thousand Dollars (\$8,000.00), or by both such fine and imprisonment.

COUNT 3: This crime is punishable by payment of a fine not exceeding Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00), or by imprisonment in the State Penitentiary for a period not exceeding ten (10) years, or by both such fine and imprisonment
