Determination of Quorum and Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 1:01pm. Ms. Hall called the roll. Board members present were Ms. Tracy Grammer, Dr. Mary Hudson, Dr. Greg A. Krempl, Mr. William Livermon and Ms. Susan McHugh. A quorum was present.

Others present: Amy Hall, Executive Secretary, Sandra Balzer, Assistant Attorney General, and Tiffany Wythe, Assistant Attorney General and guests; Mona Ryan.

Approval of Minutes from June 5, 2015 Board Meeting

Ms. McHugh moved and Mr. Livermon seconded the motion to approve the June 5 board meeting minutes as amended. Ms. Grammer, Dr. Hudson, Ms. McHugh, Mr. Livermon and Dr. Krempl voted yes with a show of hands. Motion approved.

Welcome Mona Ryan to our board. Mrs. Ryan was appointed to serve from August 18, 2015 to August 17, 2018.

No action taken.

Discussion and Possible Action on Executive Order 2015-33 from Governor Mary Fallin.

Ms. Balzer discussed the Executive Order 2015-33 that Governor Mary Fallin issued. No action taken.

Discussion and Possible Action on Recommendations Regarding Complaints Received by the Board: 15-16, 15-17, 15-18, 15-19, 15-20, 15-21, and 15-22

15-16

Dr. Hudson moved and Ms. McHugh seconded the motion to accept the recommendation to rescind the previous decision of filing a formal complaint against the supervisor and dismiss the complaint. Dr. Hudson, Dr. Krempl, Mr. Livermon, and Ms. McHugh all voted yes with roll call. Ms. Grammer abstained. Motion approved.

15-17

Ms. Balzer reported that this complaint is still under investigation. No action was needed.

15-18

15-19 and 15-20

Mr. Livermon moved and Dr. Krempl seconded the motion to accept the recommendation to dismiss both the complaints 15-19 and 15-20, as the allegations were refuted. Dr. Hudson, Dr. Krempl, Mr. Livermon, and Ms. McHugh all voted yes with roll call. Ms. Grammer abstained. Motion approved.

15-21

Ms. Balzer stated that there was sufficient evidence to find probable cause of a violation. Dr. Krempl moved and Dr. Hudson seconded the motion to proceed with a formal complaint. Dr. Hudson, Dr. Krempl, Mr. Livermon, and Ms. McHugh all voted yes with roll call. Ms. Grammer abstained. Motion approved.

15-22

Ms. Balzer stated that there was sufficient evidence to find probable cause of a violation. Dr. Krempl moved and Ms. McHugh seconded the motion to proceed with a formal complaint. Ms. Grammer, Mr. Livermon, Dr. Hudson, Dr. Krempl, and Ms. McHugh all voted yes with roll call. Motion approved.

Discussion and Possible Action on Disciplinary Matters. The Board may conduct an evidentiary hearing, consider a proposed consent order, or consider other associated matters or motions. The Board may convene in executive session for deliberations pursuant to 25 O.S. Section 307(B)(8).

a. 15-05, Danielle Klevgard, SP#4251

Ms. Balzer offered a proposed Consent Order in disposition of the complaint alleging practice with an expired license. Mr. Livermon moved and Dr. Krempl seconded the motion to accept the Consent Order as proposed. Respondent agreed to complete a corrective action plan. Mr. Livermon, Ms. McHugh, Dr. Hudson, and Dr. Krempl all voted yes with a show of hands. Ms. Grammer abstained. Motion approved.

b. 15-06, Misty Meadows, SP#3152

Ms. Meadows failed to appear for an evidentiary hearing after being properly served with notice. Ms. Balzer offered four exhibits which were admitted. Ms. Balzer called a witness, Ms. Hall, regarding Exhibit B.

Dr. Krempl moved and Mr. Livermon seconded the motion to adopt as its findings of fact and conclusions of law the allegations of fact and applicable law as set forth in the Complaint and Notice of Hearing. The motion included the following sanctions: an ethics course due September 1; audit of continuing education for 2015-2016; and submit, by September 1, a notarized statement from her employer certifying that any unpaid claims billed to third party payers for services she provided while license was expired have been withdrawn and any subsequent occurrence of practice with an expired license will result in disciplinary action. Mr. Livermon, Ms. McHugh, Dr. Hudson, and Dr. Krempl all voted yes by roll call. Ms. Grammer abstained. Motion approved.

c. 15-08, Trina Bonham, AUDA#14

Ms. Bonham failed to appear for an evidentiary hearing after being properly served with notice. Ms. Balzer offered five exhibits which were admitted. Ms. Balzer called a witness, Ms. Hall, regarding Exhibit E.

Dr. Krempl moved and Dr. Hudson seconded the motion to adopt as its findings of fact and conclusions of law the allegations of fact and applicable law as set forth in the Complaint and Notice of Hearing. The motion included the following sanctions: an ethics course due September 1 and any other subsequent occurrence with an expired authorization will result in further disciplinary action. Mr. Livermon, Ms. McHugh, Dr. Hudson, and Dr. Krempl all voted yes by roll call. Ms. Grammer abstained. Motion approved.

Discussion and Possible Action on results of audit of licensees for continuing education hours for 2013-2014.

Ms. Hall reported on the 2013-2014 continuing education audits, a continuation from the previous Board meeting. Ms. McHugh moved and Dr. Hudson seconded the motion that the following people found to be non-

compliant in the audit of continuing education for 2013-2014, Ms. Corea, Ms. Haynes, Ms. Johnson-Scott, Mr. Willhoite and Ms. Wittrock have now come into compliance. Ms. Grammer, Mr. Livermon, Dr. Hudson, Dr. Krempl, and Ms. McHugh all voted yes with roll call. Motion approved.

Discussion and Possible Action on Licensees who are non-compliant with the Oklahoma Tax Commission:

Nancy Bryant, SP#458 and Amber Diaz, SP#3274

Ms. Hall addressed the Board concerning Nancy Bryant and Amber Diaz not being tax compliant, but they did make timely renewal of their license for 2015. Amber Diaz sent an email to the Board asking for an extension to become compliant and Nancy Bryant did not contact the Board.

Dr. Krempl moved and Mr. Livermon seconded the motion to deny the renewal application for Nancy Bryant pursuant to 68 O.S. 238.1 and 750.S 314 (B)(C)(1) as stated in the letter dated June 10, 2015. Mr. Livermon, Dr. Hudson, Dr. Krempl, and Ms. McHugh all voted yes with roll call. Ms. Grammer voted nay. Motion approved.

Dr. Krempl moved and Ms. McHugh seconded the motion to table the renewal application for Amber Diaz until the next Board meeting and that we send her notification that if she is not tax compliant by the time of the meeting her renewal application will be denied. Ms. Grammer, Mr. Livermon, Dr. Hudson, Dr. Krempl, and Ms. McHugh all voted yes with roll call. Motion approved.

Discussion and Possible Action to send AAG in addition to the two new OBESPA Board members to attend the NCSB conference October 8-10 in Charlotte, North Carolina.

Dr. Krempl moved and Dr. Hudson seconded the motion to send the AAG and the two new Board members to the NCSB conference in North Carolina. Ms. Grammer, Mr. Livermon, Dr. Hudson, Dr. Krempl, and Ms. McHugh all voted yes with roll call. Motion approved.

Discussion and Possible Action on OBESPA's legislative liaison.

Dr. Krempl discussed with Board what is required of him as the legislative liaison for our Board. He is to report a monthly report on his lobbyist expenditures online between the first and fifth. If reported after the fifth then you are considered to be in violation and assessed a fine. Dr. Krempl is willing to continue to be the liaison if he could assign a designee to file the reports for him. Ms. McHugh moved and Dr. Hudson seconded the motion to allow Dr. Krempl to name Amy Hall as his designee to file state liaison reports to the Ethics Commission. Ms. Grammer, Mr. Livermon, Dr. Hudson, Dr. Krempl, and Ms. McHugh all voted yes with roll call. Motion approved.

Discussion and Possible Action on Financial Reports.

The new hyperion system was down so no reports available. No action needed.

Review and Possible Action on Submission of Executive Director's P-Card Statement for Review and Approval.

Mr. Livermon moved and Dr. Krempl seconded the motion to approve the Executive Directors P-card statement for July 2015. Ms. Grammer, Dr. Hudson Ms. McHugh, Mr. Livermon and Dr. Krempl all voted yes with a show of hands. Motion approved.

Executive Secretary report:

-Rule Update

Ms. Hall let the Board know that the new rules were approved on June 8, 2015. The rules will be published in the register on August 17 and the new rules will be effective August 27, 2015. The Board discussed ways they would like to notify the licensees of the new rule changes. Ms. Hall will be sending out an email, a letter and updating the website regarding the new rules. No action needed.

Discussion and Possible Action regarding issuing a CEY license to an applicant working less than 15 hours a week.

Ms. Balzer discussed with the Board the rules regarding licensure for a CEY. She stated that rule 690:10-3-5 has to do with licensure for an SLP not a CEY. Rule 690:10-5-2 states the requirement for licensure for a CEY and does not include a requirement that a CEY has to have a job that is 15 hours or more to apply. No action needed.
