Determination of Quorum and Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 1:01pm. Ms. Hall called the roll. Board members present were Ms. Tracy Grammer, Dr. Mary Hudson, Dr. Greg A. Krempl, Mr. William Livermon and Ms. Susan McHugh. A quorum was present.

Others present: Amy Hall, Executive Secretary, Sandra Balzer, Assistant Attorney General, Tiffany Wythe, Assistant Attorney General and guests; Shelly Walker.

Approval of Minutes from April 10, 2015 Board Meeting

Dr. Krempl moved and Ms. McHugh seconded the motion to approve the April 10 board meeting minutes as written. Ms. Grammer, Dr. Hudson, Ms. McHugh, Mr. Livermon and Dr. Krempl voted yes with a show of hands. Motion approved.

Welcome William Livermon to our board. Mr. Livermon was appointed to serve from April 20, 2015 to August 17, 2017. Mr. Livermon is replacing Ms. Hopper on our board.

Discussion and Possible Action on Recommendations Regarding Complaints Received by the Board: 15-15, 15-16 and 15-17

15-15

Ms. Balzer stated that there was sufficient evidence to find probable cause of a violation. Dr. Krempl moved and Dr. Hudson seconded the motion to proceed with a formal complaint. Dr. Hudson, Dr. Krempl, and Ms. McHugh all voted yes with roll call. Ms. Grammer and Mr. Livermon abstained. Motion approved.

Ms. Balzer stated that there was sufficient evidence to find probable cause of a violation. Dr. Krempl moved and Dr. Hudson seconded the motion to proceed with a formal complaint. Dr. Hudson, Dr. Krempl, and Ms. McHugh all voted yes with roll call. Ms. Grammer and Mr. Livermon abstained. Motion approved.

a. 14-02, Shelly Walker, SP #2019 Review of Non-Compliance with Consent Order

Ms. Walker was present without an attorney. Ms. Balzer presented evidence regarding Ms. Walker's compliance with the terms of the Consent Order. Ms. Walker presented evidence of completion of continuing education

After initial discussion, Ms. McHugh moved and Dr. Hudson seconded the motion to go into executive session. Dr. Hudson, Dr. Krempf, Mr. Livermon and Ms. McHugh all voted yes by roll call. Ms. Grammer recused herself. Motion approved.

Mr. Livermon moved and Dr. Krempf seconded the motion to come out of executive session. Dr. Hudson, Dr. Krempf, Mr. Livermon and Ms. McHugh all voted yes with a show of hands. Ms. Grammer recused herself. Motion approved.

Dr. Krempf moved and Mr. Livermon seconded the motion to find Ms. Walker in non-compliance of the consent order and impose the following sanctions: (1) a fine of \$100 be paid in 60 days; (2) submit proof of 0.5 continuing education hours within 30 days; (3) the continuing education hours for 2013-2014 including the hours presented at the hearing and the 0.5 hour shall not count towards Ms. Walker's 2015-2016 continuing education period; and (4) a letter of caution be issued. Dr. Hudson, Dr. Krempf, Mr. Livermon and Ms. McHugh all voted yes by roll call. Ms. Grammer recused herself. Motion approved.

Mr. Livermon, Ms. McHugh, Dr. Hudson, and Dr. Krempf all voted yes with a show of hands. Ms. Grammer abstained. Motion approved.

Ms. Balzer offered a proposed Consent Order in disposition of the complaint alleging practice with an expired license. Ms. McHugh moved and Mr. Livermon seconded the motion to accept the Consent Order as proposed. Respondent agreed to pay a fine of \$300 and complete a corrective action plan. Mr. Livermon, Ms. McHugh, Dr. Hudson, and Dr. Krempf all voted yes with a show of hands. Ms. Grammer abstained. Motion approved.

j. 15-10, Kathleen Plumb, SP#358, 15-11, Adrienne Rogers, SP#258, and 15-12, Michelle Shewey, SP#2676 Proposed Consent Orders

Ms. Balzer offered a proposed Consent Order in disposition of the complaint alleging practice with an expired license. Dr. Krempl moved and Dr. Hudson seconded the motion to accept the Consent Order as proposed. Respondent agreed to complete a corrective action plan. Mr. Livermon, Ms. McHugh, Dr. Hudson, and Dr. Krempl all voted yes with a show of hands. Ms. Grammer abstained. Motion approved.

Discussion and Possible Action on results of audit of licensees for continuing education hours for 2013-2014.

Ms. Hall reported on the 2013-2014 continuing education audits, a continuation from the previous Board meeting. Ms. McHugh reported on her review of the audit of Rusty Willhoite. Mr. Willhoite is short 3.65 hours to complete his 20 hours. Dr. Krempl moved and Mr. Livermon seconded the motion to send a certified letter to Mr. Willhoite giving him 90 days from receipt of the letter to provide evidence of the CE hours; provide proof of hours short during 2013-2014 and pay a fine of \$42.50 or complete the hours needed during the 90 days and pay a fine of \$42.50. If the board has not received the documentation of continuing education and the fee in the allotted time, the board will take disciplinary action against the licensee. Any CE hours accrued during the 90-day period may not count toward the 2015-2016 continuing education requirements. The failure to comply with the 2013-2014 audit results in an automatic CE audit for 2015-2016 period. Ms. Grammer, Mr. Livermon, Dr. Hudson, Dr. Krempl, and Ms. McHugh all voted yes with roll call. Motion approved.

Dr. Hudson moved and Mr. Livermon seconded the motion to send certified letters to Denise Barrett and Rachel Shearer giving them 90 days from receipt of the letter to provide evidence of the CE hours; they can provide proof of hours short during 2013-2014 and pay a fine of \$42.50 or complete the hours needed during the 90 days and pay a fine of \$42.50. If the board has not received the documentation of continuing education and the fee in the allotted time, the board will take disciplinary action against them. Any CE hours accrued during the 90-day period may not count toward the 2015-2016 continuing education requirements. The failure to comply with the 2013-2014 audit results in an automatic CE audit for 2015-2016 period. Ms. Grammer, Mr. Livermon, Dr. Hudson, Dr. Krempl, and Ms. McHugh all voted yes with roll call. Discussion and Possible Action on Licensees who are non-compliant with the Oklahoma Tax Commission:

Nancy Bryant, SP#458 and Amber Diaz, SP#3274

Ms. Hall addressed the Board concerning Nancy Bryant and Amber Diaz not being tax compliant, but they did make timely renewal of their license for 2015. Dr. Krempl moved and Dr. Hudson seconded the motion to table the renewal of Nancy Bryant and Amber Diaz until next Board meeting and send them a letter to notify them that a final decision will be made regarding their renewal at the July 24th meeting. Ms. Grammer, Mr. Livermon, Dr. Hudson, Dr. Krempl, and Ms. McHugh all voted yes with a show of hands. Motion approved.

Election of Board Officers: Chairman, Vice Chairman and Secretary

Dr. Krempl moved and Mr. Livermon seconded the motion to elect Susan McHugh for Chair, Mary Hudson for Vice Chair and Mona Ryan for Secretary. Dr. Hudson, Mr. Livermon, Dr. Krempl, Ms. Grammer and Ms. McHugh all voted yes with a show of hands. Motion approved.

Board took a break at 3:48 and reconvened at 3:52

Discussion and Possible Action on reporting to ASHA on complaints received by the Board.

Ms. Balzer discussed with the Board the standing open records request from ASHA regarding sending all disciplinary matters including confidential investigation files. Mr. Livermon moved and Ms. McHugh seconded the motion to disclose to ASHA the information they have requested which is a copy of the original complaint and evidence the Board relied upon for each matter. Mr. Livermon, Dr. Krempl, Ms. Grammer and Ms. McHugh all voted yes with a show of hands. Dr. Hudson abstained. Motion approved.

Discussion and Possible action on Administrative Assistant position.

Ms. Hall discussed with the Board regarding the position of the Administrative Assistant. Dr. Krempl, Ms. Grammer and Ms. Hall met with OMES to discuss the budget for OBESPA. The goal of the meeting was to determine if the board has sufficient financial resources to retain an administrative assistant to assist the Executive Secretary. Ms. Johnson with OMES explained why the previous budget had not been calculated correctly. Appropriate corrections to the budget were made. It was determined that the board has adequate

financial resources to retain a part-time administrative assistant position that is eligible for benefits. No further action needed.

Discussion and Possible Action on Financial Reports.

Ms. Hall reviewed the financial reports from April 2015 and May 2015. No action needed.

Review and Possible Action on Submission of Executive Director's P-Card Statement for Review and Approval.

Dr. Krempl moved and Dr. Hudson seconded the motion to approve the Executive Directors P-card statement for April 2015 and May 2015. Ms. Grammer, Dr. Hudson Ms. McHugh, Mr. Livermon and Dr. Krempl all voted affirmatively with a show of hands. Motion approved.
