Determination of Quorum and Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 1:02pm. Tracy Grammer called the roll. Board members present were Dr. Mary Hudson, Ms. Tracy Grammer, Dr. Greg A. Krempl, Ms. Susan McHugh and Ms. Kristin Hopper. A quorum was present.

Others present: Amy Hall, Executive Secretary, Sandra Balzer, Assistant Attorney General, Tiffany Wythe, Assistant Attorney General and guests; Abby O'Dell, Mona Ryan and Kathy Wheat.

Welcome Susan McHugh, M.Ed. to the Board. Ms. McHugh was appointed to serve a three term beginning August 17, 2014 and ending August 17, 2017. Ms. McHugh replaced Dr. Giddens on the Board.

Ms. Grammer welcomed Ms. McHugh to our Board.

Approval of Minutes from August 15, 2014 Board Meeting

Dr. Krempl moved and Ms. Hopper seconded the motion to approve the August 15 board meeting minutes as written. Ms. Grammer, Dr. Hudson, Ms. McHugh, Ms. Hopper and Dr. Krempl voted yes with a show of hands. Motion approved.

Discussion and Possible Action on Disciplinary Matters. The Board may conduct an evidentiary hearing, consider a proposed consent order, or consider other associated matters or motions. The Board may convene in executive session for deliberations pursuant to 25 O.S. Section 307(B)(8).

13-19, Mendee House, SP#3583 Respondent's Motion for Extension of Time to Comply with Certain Consent Order Requirement or Amend/Waive the Requirement

The Board reviewed information regarding Ms. House's compliance with the terms of the Consent Order. Ms. Balzer reminded the Board that Ms. House had previously been granted an extension from July 1 to Oct 27. Ms. House was not present but is requesting an extension because of the difficulty she is having obtaining the affidavit from her employer. Dr. Krempl moved and Ms. McHugh seconded the motion to amend the consent order to extend the deadline until December 12, that Ms. House provides documentation confirming the receipt of the certified letter and a representative of the Board will contact Amy Phipps. Dr. Hudson, Dr. Krempl, Ms. Hopper and Ms. McHugh all voted yes with a show of hands. Ms. Grammer abstained. Motion approved.

13-25, James Vint, SP #3971 Review of Compliance with Consent Order

Dr. Hudson moved and Ms. Hopper seconded the motion to dismiss complaint 13-25 against James Vint, showing compliance of all terms in consent order. Dr. Hudson, Dr. Krempl, Ms. Hopper, Ms. Grammer and Ms. McHugh all voted yes by roll call. Motion approved

14-03 Diana Harrington, SP #3242 Respondent's Motion for Extension of Time to Comply with Certain Consent Order Terms

Ms. Balzer reviewed information with the Board regarding Ms. Harrington's compliance with the terms of the Consent Order. Ms. Harrington is requesting an extension for more time to complete the continuing education and the report. Ms. Harrington was present at the Board meeting by phone to answer questions about what portions of the consent order have been met, what her next steps are and why no continuing education is completed yet. After initial discussion, Dr. Krempl moved and Ms. McHugh seconded the motion to go into executive session. Dr. Hudson, Dr. Krempl, Ms. Hopper and Ms. McHugh all voted yes by roll call. Ms. Grammer recused herself. Motion approved.

Dr. Krempl moved and Ms. Hopper seconded the motion to come out of executive session. Ms. Grammer, Ms. McHugh, Ms. Hopper and Dr. Krempl all voted yes with a show of hands. Motion approved.

Ms. Hopper made a statement that she is an acquaintance of Diana Harrington but is completely impartial in this case and can move forward due to the facts.

Dr. Krempl moved and Dr. Hudson seconded the motion to extend Ms. Harrington's deadline to December 12th and to give Ms. Harrington written approval of the CEU's listed 1-5 on the email from Ms. Harrington dated October 7. Dr. Hudson, Dr. Krempl, Ms. Hopper and Ms. McHugh all voted yes by roll call. Ms. Grammer recused herself. Motion approved.

Discussion and Possible Action on Recommendations Regarding Complaints Received by the Board:

Ms. Balzer stated that there was sufficient evidence to find probable cause of a violation. Ms. McHugh moved and Dr. Hudson seconded the motion to proceed with a formal complaint. Dr. Hudson, Dr. Krempl, Ms. Hopper and Ms. McHugh all voted yes with a show of hands. Ms. Grammer recused herself. Motion approved

Dr. Krempl, Ms. Hopper, Ms. McHugh and Ms. Grammer all voted yes with roll call. Dr. Hudson opposed. Motion approved.

Dr. Krempl moved and Ms. Hopper seconded the motion to strike his prior motion pertaining to complaint 14-13. Dr. Hudson, Dr. Krempl, Ms. Hopper, Ms. Grammer and Ms. McHugh all voted yes with a show of hands. Motion approved.

Dr. Krempl moved and Ms. McHugh seconded the motion to open a formal investigation with the appropriate Board approved investigator. Dr. Krempl, Ms. Hopper, Ms. McHugh and Ms. Grammer all voted yes with roll call. Dr. Hudson opposed. Motion approved.

Review and Possible Action to consider extension of deadline to complete terms of voluntary agreement for licensure of Julie Goodwin.

Ms. Goodwin is requesting an extension for getting her psychology services set up. Ms. Balzer reviewed with the Board the terms of the voluntary agreement and the issues that Ms. Goodwin is having making an appointment with a psychologist. Ms. Balzer stated that this is the second time the Board has made an

extension for Ms. Goodwin. Dr. Hudson moved and Dr. Krempl moved to extend the deadline until December 12th. Dr. Hudson, Dr. Krempl, Ms. Hopper and Ms. McHugh all voted yes with a show of hands. Ms. Grammer recused herself. Motion approved.

Review and Discussion of Proposed Permanent Rule Changes and Possible Action to Initiate Rulemaking Process.

Ms. Hall and Ms. McHugh presented to the Board information that was given at the NCSB conference. No action taken.

New Business

Dr. Krempl wanted the Board to discuss at the next Board meeting the Board's obligation on reporting to ASHA unprofessional behavior. No action taken.

Review and possible action on pending licensure applications and assistant applications. List Below

Ms. Hall addressed the Board concerning the licensure application of David Cutler. Mr. Cutler answered yes to one of the discipline questions on his application that he had a complaint from a previous state. The Board reviewed the complaint from the Utah Board and discussed what actions to take in granting him a license in our state. The Board deferred approval for Mr. Cutler pending receipt of additional information regarding his prior discipline in Utah.

Dr. Krempl moved and Ms. McHugh seconded the motion to approve the applicants for assistant licensure with the exception of Kimberly Tilley. Ms. Grammer, Dr. Hudson, Dr. Krempl and Ms. McHugh all voted yes with a show of hands. Motion approved.

Ms. McHugh moved and Dr. Krempl seconded the motion to approve the applicants for full licensure with the exception of David Cutler. Ms. Grammer, Dr. Hudson, Dr. Krempl and Ms. McHugh all voted yes with a show of hands. Motion approved.

Dr. Krempl moved and Dr. Hudson seconded the motion to approve the applicants for CEY licensure. Ms. Grammer, Dr. Hudson, Dr. Krempl and Ms. McHugh all voted yes with a show of hands. Motion approved.
