Community-Oriented Proactive Narcotics Education and Training (COPNET)

The Oklahoma Bureau of Narcotics in partnership with Americorps, is looking for 20 energetic individuals who can meet the challenge of conducting drug awareness education and training programs across the state of Oklahoma through a program called COPNET.

COPNET instructors will teach drug awareness classes to Oklahoma's children, young adults, school faculty members, administrators, and other concerned citizens.



COPNET Employment Requirements

1. Be at least 20 years of age.
2. Possess a valid Oklahoma Drivers License.
3. No felony or drug convictions.
4. Able to travel to different areas of the state.
5. Pass a background investigation and polygraph.
6. Have a working knowledge of Microsoft Word and Power-Point.
7. Interview with the Director of the Oklahoma Bureau of Narcotics, or his designee, the Agent in Charge of Training, and the COPNET Project Director.
8. Willing to positively impact the lives of young people in Oklahoma!

If you are a college student, you must:

- a. Currently hold a Junior, Senior. or Graduate level at a State-Certified College.
 - b. Have at least a 2.5 GPA.
- » Provide a letter of recommendation from a professor at the college where you currently attend.

COPNET instructors, (900 hour) will be part-time employees:

- » \$754.38 (approx) per month living allowance
- » \$2,362.50 educational stipend upon successful completion of 900 service hours at the end of each service year.

COPNET instructors, (450 hour) will be part-time employees:

- » \$476.47 (approx.) per month living allowance
- » \$1,250.00 educational stipend upon successful completion of 450 hours

COPNET instructors, (300 hour) will be part-time employees:

- » \$251.54 (approx.) per month living allowance
- » \$1,000.00 educational stipend upon successful completion of 300 hours
- » Members must sign contract with OBN/Americorps.
