

Medical Marijuana Business Applicant FAQ

*****Make sure to check your spam folder for emails from OBND*****

How do I apply for an OBND Registration?

An online application is available at www.obnregistration.ok.gov. When you complete the application online a 5 digit OBND number is generated but listed as PENDING until your application has been reviewed and approved. A paper application is also available at www.ok.gov/obndd under the left menu titled OBN Registration Forms. When the paper application is submitted a 5 digit OBND number will not be generated until AFTER your application has been reviewed and approved.

What type of registration do I apply for?

Growers and processors will apply as a Manufacturer which is \$500. Dispensaries will apply as a CDS Distributor which is \$300. ******Please note do not apply on the Pseudoephedrine application. This is the wrong type and will delay your application.***

I have multiple license types with OMMA, do I therefore have to obtain multiple OBND Registrations?

You are required to have an OBND registration for each address the controlled substance activity will be taking place. Example: If you have a grow at one address and a dispensary at a separate location you would be required to get two OBND registrations.

You can operate multiply activities under one OBND registration, IF they are both under the exact same business name and address. Example: If you have a processor and dispensary at the same address and under the same business name you would only need one Manufacturer registration. ******Please note you cannot operate a business under another business name's registration even if they have the same owners.***

How long does the application process take?

Once we receive all completed paperwork and payment, processing time can be approximately 3 weeks. Processing time can vary depending on the number of application we are currently receiving. ******Please note applications can be delayed due to incomplete or wrong information on the application. Also if the information provided on our application, ex. business name and address, does not match what OMMA has your application will be delayed until the information is corrected.***

What all has to be submitted for an OBND registration?

1. Manufacturer or Distributor Application
2. Payment
3. Medical Marijuana Owner Information Forms (Found at www.ok.gov/obndd under the left menu titled OBN Registration Forms.)

******Please note you MUST have an OMMA license before we can even accept or review your initial OBND application.***

The application asks for a DEA number and an NPI number, do I have to get those?

No, you will not get a DEA number or NPI number and you should mark the Pending/NA box on the application.

What schedules do I mark on the application?

You should mark Schedule 1 Medical Marijuana Only.

How long is this registration good for?

All of our registrations expire on October 31st. Any applications approved between July 1, 2019-June 30, 2020 will have an expiration date of 10/31/2020. Any applications approved after July 1, 2020 will have an expiration date of 10/31/2021.

How do I change the business address?

You will FIRST have to update your address with OMMA. Then you can submit an address change form that is located at www.ok.gov/obndd under the left menu titled OBN Registration Forms. We cannot change the address until we can verify the address change has been completed with OMMA.

******If you have not changed your address with OMMA yet, contact them at www.omma.ok.gov or 405-522-6662.***

What should I do if closing my business?

You will be required to send a letter stating your intention to close your business. Once we receive your letter we will contact you with further information.

How do I add or remove owners from my business?

To add owners to an existing OBNDD registration, the current owner will need to send a letter to our office stating you are wanting to add additional owners. New Medical Marijuana Owner Information Forms will need to be submitted for all current and incoming owners.

To remove an owner from an existing OBNDD registration, you will need to send a letter to our office stating which owners are being removed. Once we receive your letter we will contact you with further information.

******MMJ Transport and MMJ Waste Disposal Businesses are NOT required to register with OBNDD******
