RULE IMPACT STATEMENT

Description of proposed rule: The proposed rule amendments updates the reference to the Code of Federal Regulations as the section numbers have changed.

Persons most likely affected: Registrants will be most affected as they will be directed to the correct section numbers in the Code of Federal Regulations referenced in the OBN rules.

Probable costs/benefits to agencies: The proposed rule amendments will not subject State agencies to any additional costs.
