CHAPTER 45. OKLAHOMA CONTROL REPORTING REQUIREMENTS**

**RULE IMPACT STATEMENT**

**Description of proposed rule:** The proposed rule amendments adds the reporting of a phone number to the list of required reported information to the central repository.

**Persons most likely affected:** Pharmacies and dispensing practitioners will be most affected as they are the entities that routinely report to the central repository.

**Persons benefitting from proposed rules:** Practitioners, investigators and others that search the central repository will benefit from the proposed rule as the phone number adds an additional way to differentiate between persons on the central repository who may have the same name or date of birth, etc.

**Probable economic impact:** There is not a probable economic impact.

**Probable costs/benefits to agencies:** The proposed rule amendments will not subject State agencies to any additional costs.

**Impact upon political subdivisions:** The proposed rule amendments have no economic impact upon political subdivisions, nor do they require any cooperation or effort from them to implement.

**Impact upon small business:** The proposed rule amendments will have no additional impact on small business.

**Consideration of alternative methods and means:** There are no less intrusive means of achieving the goals of the proposed rules.

**Effects upon public health, safety and environment:** The proposed rule amendments have no environmental impact, nor a direct effect upon public health and safety.

**Public health, safety and environmental threats in absence of rules:** This rule just adds an additional identifier to the central repository so as to differentiate between individuals when running a search report.

**Date of preparation of rule impact statement:**
