



Noteworthy Programs Summary

Tulsa Women and Children's Center

The Tulsa Women and Children's Center is a 52-bed facility owned by the Oklahoma Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services, with treatment services provided by Palmer Continuum of Care, a subsidiary of Palmer Drug Abuse Program of Tulsa.

The center offers a comprehensive, gender-specific substance abuse treatment program that focuses on a number of areas including addiction, spirituality, relationships, parenting skills, education and job training, and addresses issues related to physical or emotional violence in the home.

Clients live at the center, with their children, from four to six months. Upon graduation, components are in place that will allow these women to succeed, including job searches, suitable housing, child care and aftercare counseling.

Family & Children's Services

Family & Children's Services is one of the premier human service providers in Northeastern Oklahoma. The agency provides counseling services, parenting education, child abuse prevention and treatment, literacy programs, marriage and family strengthening programs, early childhood family support, youth development programs and mental health services. Last year, its programs touched more than 60,000 lives. Family & Children's Services partners with families, schools, business and other organizations to share resources and develop comprehensive solutions to the problems that threaten the well-being of families and our community. The agency is accredited by the Council on Accreditation for Children and Family Services and is a member of the Alliance for Children and Families, the Tulsa Area United Way and the National Child Traumatic Stress Network. F&CS Mental Health Care is certified as a community mental health center by the Oklahoma Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services.
