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MEETING NOTES

<p>Transition to Adulthood – Policy Academy MOA</p>	<p>The Transition to Adulthood WG meeting is today (2/10) from 3:30 – 5:00 @ CO. Jackie to check with Teresa Kaemmerling to see if the Teenage Pregnancy Prevention WG is the same as the Interagency ICC meeting.</p> <p>We have approval for to send 4-5 people to the Cincinnati to tour the Lighthouse continuum of housing and receive training, and the Innovation Group will provide the funding. The WG will decide this afternoon on the attendees.</p> <p>MOA – team discussed changing the wording within the document. Jackie had received input from Georgetown on changes. Funding wording should perhaps include “new, redirected, or enhanced”. Mental Health, DHS, & OJA may be the key three funding streams. Plan is to present updated MOA to the Directors and Commissioners for signature, then to The Partnership for Children’s Behavioral Health. This MOA re-affirms the original MOA and adds objectives for “transitioning youth”.</p>
<p>Transition to Adulthood – Jobs</p>	<p>Dennis reported that Dee Blose will be hosting a meeting at Sarkeys in Norman, which will focus on joint planning and on promoting public/private partnerships. The Federal Reserve Bank in OKC will be at the next meeting to provide information. Next meeting is scheduled on 2/27 at 3:00 pm @ OHCA.</p> <p>Dennis to send the bill # to Joanne Verity.</p>
<p>Care Management Project</p>	<p>It is moving forward. The Care Managers are doing a great job building up their case loads.</p>
<p>Goals of Summit</p>	<p>4-step process leading up to Summit. 199 responses to web survey, which helped create the workgroups for the Summit. Approximately 150 people are registered to attend the Summit. Each workgroup will have between 10-15 participants along with a facilitator, SME, and recorder.</p> <p>The 10 workgroups are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Workforce Recruitment & Retention • Rural and Tribal Access to Care • Holistic Approach to Services • Public Health Approach to Children’s Wellness • Supporting Community Coalitions • Working with the Birth to Five Population • Reducing Disparities in Mental Health Care • Co-Occurring Screening, Assessments • Substance Abuse Education for Children/Youth • Transition to Adulthood <p>The recommendations from each group will be brought back to BHDT to update the action plan.</p>
<p>Children’s Day @ the Capitol</p>	<p>We have 10 agencies scheduled for booth space so please contact Jeff Tallent if you want a booth (maximum of 30 booths). We certainly want enough people there to have an impact. Mark your calendar – March 5 from 8:00 – 12:00.</p> <p>Suggestion to invite Social Security Admin. Amy sent note to OFF about suggestion.</p>

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<p>Children's Coordinated Budget</p>	<p>We will have information available about children's health at Day @ the Capitol. Continual education is the key and may take years but will hopefully lead to the desired end result. Maybe we find one thing at the top of our list (i.e. Adolescent In-patient Substance Abuse Treatment) and try to push that through. It hits OJA, DHS, Mental Health – impacts many agencies. Need to coordinate with Steve Buck or Nikko to be most effective. We need to continue the concept because it's the right thing to do. Need to process at next meeting.</p>
<p>Medical Home Progress</p>	<p>We are back to re-introducing waiver request back to the Feds for kids. Looks like we are clean to move forward to 300% poverty for kids. It's funded but <i>not a done thing</i>. Kids after 185% will go into Ensure OK. They will have a different package (more commercial, including co-pays). The good thing is it's good health care coverage. No wrong door, online enrollment – OHCA is very excited about how this might positively impact OK.</p> <p>Medical Home – within SoonerCare and Ensure OK, there's a focus to tie people to PCP's. PCP's are now fee-for-service and we're encouraging a designated PCP, whenever possible. Individuals will still be able to go to another doctor when their PCP isn't available. The goal is to keep people out of the emergency room.</p> <p>APS – primary care doctors can call and consult with psychiatrics on mental health questions. <i>This is a great thing so please spread the word.</i></p> <p>These items will be discussed during State Advisory Team – next Friday, 2/20.</p>
<p>State Advisory Team</p>	<p>New SAMSHA grant (expanding SOC in rural parts of OK) will have a sub-group of the SAT assigned to focus on the grant activities. Essential agencies are: DHS (county director), OJA (Cathy Olberding), OFF, OAYS, Mental Health Center representative (connect via video conferencing), Revolution, Care Manager from new state level project. Email sent out 2/10 from Jackie requesting participation.
