

Per ODMHSAS Service Manual for Childrens HH Roles

Family Support and Training provider (FSP): Family Support Provider training is offered monthly

- Successful completion of Family Support Training according to a curriculum approved by the ODMHSAS.
- All new children HH staff that meet the requirements are required to take the E-learning Wraparound training, two day face to face Wraparound training, and attend one day face to face family support provider training.

Wraparound Facilitator Case Manager(Care Coordinator) (SOC): Wraparound 101 2 day face to face training is offered twice a month in OKC & Tulsa

- Successful completion of the ODMHSAS training for wraparound facilitation within six months of employment; and 2) participates in ongoing coaching provided by ODMHSAS and employing agency; and 3) successfully completes wraparound credentialing process within nine months of beginning process.
- All new children HH staff that meet the requirements are required to take the E-learning Wraparound training and two day face to face Wraparound training

Behavioral Health Aide (BHA): BHA training is offered either every other month or at minimum quarterly

- Must have successfully completed the specialized training and education curriculum provided by the ODMHSAS.

All new children HH staff that meet the requirements are required to take the E-learning Wraparound training, two day face to face Wraparound training, take the E-learning BHA training, and one day face to face BHA training.
