

2010 Oklahoma Public Sector County Results




The overall Public Sector Incidence Rate for Oklahoma is 5.0 work-related injuries and illnesses per 100 employees.

Of Oklahoma's Public Sector County Government, 512 units reported 14,078 employees for the 77 counties. Out of the 682 total cases, 592 were injuries and 90 were illnesses.

The *reported employment* decreased from 14,233 in 2009 to 14,078 in 2010, slightly over one (1) percent.

County Lost-Workday Case Rates

The County Government *cases with days away from work, job transfer, or restriction rate* (2010 DART Rate) is 2.46, slightly higher than last years of 2.45. The **DART Rate** includes injury and illness cases that resulted in one or more days away from work (lost-workday cases) or cases with job restrictions or transfer.

In 2010, there were 358 cases of recordable work-related *injuries and illnesses that did not result in any lost work time*, restricted time or job transfer, compared to 426 in 2009. This is almost a 16 percent decline.
