Mrs. Neville said one hundred ten (110) conversion reports have been received this year. Mrs. Neville said Alternative Fuels Technicians no longer are required to be employed by a licensed Alternative Fuels Company for a license to be issued.

ACOG and INCOG Updates

Angelia Hankins provided ACOG and INCOG updates. Ms. Hankins reported on the Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality (ODEQ) roll outs including approximately three and one half million dollars (\$3,500,000) available for reimbursement to replace or repower eligible on-road vehicles and the ChargeOK Grant Program, with grants available for the purchase, installation, and operation of publicly accessible EV charging stations throughout Oklahoma.

Ms. Hankins discussed the NGV Uptime Grant. Ms. Hankins announced the Oklahoma Electric Vehicle Coalition Meeting will be held August 11 and the Clean Cities Award luncheon has been rescheduled to the end of September.
