

## Proclamation

**Whereas**, to ensure rides are mechanically and structurally safe for riders, the Oklahoma Department of Labor inspects all permanent and movable amusement park rides; and

**Whereas**, the Oklahoma Department of Labor proposes to expand its scope of safety awareness to include rider and operator behaviors and responsibilities; and

**Whereas**, the National Safety Council Fixed-Site Amusement Ride Injury survey estimates in 2014 there were 0.7 injuries per one million patron rides with 1.57 billion rides nationally; and


**Whereas**, it is fitting to recognize and promote safety awareness within the amusement ride industry;
