BOILER INSPECTIONS FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. Does my Boiler need to be inspected?

- Yes, all known boiler/pressure vessels within the State of Oklahoma are inspected with the exception of Federal facilities and Private residences. Federal facilities will be inspected upon request only.

2. How often do they need to be inspected?

- High Pressure Boilers (Steam) and Low Pressure Boilers (Heating) are inspected once a year.
- Pressure Vessels (Unfired) are inspected every three (3) years.

3. Can I schedule an inspection?

- Yes, please provide us what county you are in for us to direct you to the correct inspector for Boiler inspections.

4. How much is it for an inspection?

• A. State Inspections

1. \$50.00 certificate fee for Boiler/Pressure vessels without a man way
2. \$155.00 for inspection fee
3. \$75.00 certificate fee for Boiler/Pressure vessels with a man way
4. \$25.00 certificate fee only for public facilities for any Boiler/Public Pressure vessels are exempt.

Example - \$155.00 (inspection fee) + \$75.00 (certificate fee) = \$230.00 with man way

Example - \$155.00 (inspection fee) + \$50.00 (certificate fee) = \$205.00 without man way

• B. Insurance Inspections

1. \$50.00 for certificate fee only
2. \$25.00 certificate fee only for public facilities
3. Public facility pressure vessels are exempt from the fees
4. All boiler and pressure vessels of Historical significance are exempt from inspections fees, they will be charged for the certificate fee of \$25.00

Note: Federal institutions are not bound by the state law to have regular boiler/pressure vessel inspections. However, if they submit a written request for an inspection they are then bound by the law to comply with all requirements as set forth in the Boiler/Pressure Vessel by the state law. Also, the facility must be consistent by using our inspectors each year. If they change their mind from year to year we will cease doing their inspections. If the Federal facilities choose to be inspected such as post offices, Indian hospitals, etc. they are not exempt from any fees.

The FAA is Government operated under Federal control, we have no jurisdiction.

- 5. Do I pay from the inspection report for the inspection or will you send an invoice?**
 - You can pay from the invoice that is left at the time of the inspection just be sure to return a copy of the invoice and contact information with the payment.
- 6. Can I get an original invoice?**
 - Yes, we can reprint an invoice.
- 7. Has this invoice been paid?**
 - Please provide the OK# or Invoice# for us to verify if the payment has been made.
- 8. Can I pay with a credit card? Can I pay Online?**
 - Yes, you can pay with a credit over the phone by contacting the Licensing Division at (405)521-6100 or (888)269-5353. At this time online payment is not an option.
- 9. What forms of payment do we accept?**
 - We accept cash (in person only), MasterCard, Visa, money order, cashier's check or check payable to ODOL.
- 10. I received my inspection/invoice but I didn't get my certificate. Why?**
 - If an invoice was issued, you will receive your certificate once the fee has been paid. If the fee has been paid, please provide us with the OK# and we will verify if we have received payment.
- 11. Why did I get a certificate of operation for one object but not the other?**
 - It may expire a different time or it may not have passed inspection. If you provide us with the OK# we can check on it for you.
- 12. Can you provide me with the name of a company that will work on my boiler?**
 - Go to labor.ok.gov and on the homepage you will see SEARCH SITE, enter Installer Master List and your options will appear.
