

Elevator Mechanics Examination Information

Mechanics examination:

1. Test date is ONLY on the third Thursday of each month.
2. Test starts at 1:00 p.m. and ends at 3:00 p.m.
3. Test consist of thirty open book questions.
4. Must pass exam with seventy percent or better.

Preparation and guidance for exam:

1. Review the Oklahoma Elevator Safety Act.
2. Read questions carefully, you may be asked to provide references (where answer is located in the law).
3. Do not spend too much time on one question, bypass it and come back to it if time permits.
4. Before turning in the exam, review your answers to make sure all have been answered.

Practice Questions:

1. What is the effective date of the Oklahoma Elevator Safety Law and where in the law is this found?
2. What is the adopted National Standard for requirements for new elevators and escalators?
3. Who is the defining authority for interpreting the rules of the Oklahoma Elevator Safety Law?
4. What are two reasons that a contractor might request a night time inspection?
5. Temporary elevators shall be inspected how often and where is it found in the law?
6. How often are elevators inspected in locations whose occupants are mobility restricted, such as nursing homes and residential care facilities and where is this founded in the law?
7. What is the duration of a Temporary Elevator Mechanics license?
8. What standard is to be used when an existing elevator does not have the original manufacturers operating and maintenance requirements available for guidance?
