ANNOUNCING ELEVATOR LICENSE TRAINING AND EXAMINATION AT LABOR DEPARTMENT

OKLAHOMA CITY – Labor Commissioner Mark Costello has issued a notice of training for Elevator Inspectors. The license training and examination will be offered at the Oklahoma Department of Labor located at 3017 N. Stiles in Oklahoma City.

Training sessions will be held Wednesday, July 11 from 9- 5 with examination to follow on Thursday, July 12 from 9-1pm. Space is limited so the Labor Department has asked that individuals interested must call 405.521-6100 and notify the Statistical, Safety and Licensing Division by Monday, July 9, if they plan to attend. The cost for the examination is \$100.

The Elevator Safety law and rules were enacted in 2006 to regulate all aspects of the elevator industry. The Oklahoma Department of Labor has jurisdiction to ensure that elevators, escalators, moving sidewalks and similar devices are installed, maintained and regularly inspected in compliance with recognized safety standards and codes. All elevator contractors, elevator mechanics, and elevator inspectors are required to be licensed by the state.
