OKLAHOMA LABOR COMMISSIONER MARK COSTELLO AIDS WISCONSIN GOVERNOR WALKER

Oklahoma City – Labor Commissioner Mark Costello announced today that he would visit Wisconsin to aid Governor Scott Walker in his upcoming recall election where Walker is facing a well-organized and well-funded movement to recall him from office. As Wisconsin Governor Walker heads into the final stretch to hang onto his governorship, Costello will be joining campaign efforts on Monday and Tuesday by visiting campaign offices and making campaign appearances in support of Governor Walker.

Walker has dominated political debates on both sides by defining the issues and citing that the current path of expensive pension and benefit packages for public employees is unsustainable. He also faced the unions in a fight to curtail collective bargaining rights. Costello stated, “Walker is the first Governor in the Wisconsin’s history to face a recall, I believe on June 5 he will prevail.”

“I’m very enthusiastic about aiding Walker in his campaign efforts,” Costello said. “Not only is Governor Walker a governor with the interests of all the people in Wisconsin, but he has a great plan for moving Wisconsin forward and turning the economy around.”
