Description of Amendment:

Question 1: Can you provide past bid results.
Answer: ODOT was not the Agency of record for the last Division 4 Solicitation. You would need to contact Linda Lechtenberg (linda.lechtenberg@omes.ok.gov) at Central Purchasing to obtain that information.

Question 2. . I would also like to know if the vegetation that is currently on quite a few areas that are required to be swept will be taken care of if we were awarded the contract. If not would we be paid more to take care of that on a change order.
Answer: The contractor will be responsible for all vegetation along walls that are swept. There will be no additional compensation provided for this, the vender should bid with that understanding. The vegetation can be cut by weed eaters or chemically controlled, although the herbicides shall approved by ODOT.

Question 3. I would also like to know if two crash trucks are to be used for the sweeping procedure per ATSSA Guidelines.

Answer: Yes we recommend a TMA (Truck mounted Attenuator) with arrow board to follow swept.
