

Possess a baccalaureate degree from an accredited institution. (Accredited institution is defined as one that is authorized or accepted by a state as fulfilling the state's educational requirement for initial teaching licensure or school counseling licensure.)

Completed 3 years of successful teaching in one or more early childhood, elementary, middle, or secondary schools. Applicants for ECYA School Counseling must have completed 3 years of successful service as a school counselor. Can be in your 3rd year of teaching when you apply.

Met the teacher licensure requirements established by Oklahoma and hold a valid teaching license (A school counseling license is required for candidacy in ECYA School Counseling.)

Commit to completing the NBPTS assessment process.

Commit to be a mentor to future candidates.
