OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT REPORT – December 2018 Metropolitan statistical area (MSA), county and other subarea information

Unemployment rates down over the year for most counties in Oklahoma in December

In December, **Latimer County** posted Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate of 5.6 percent. **McCurtain County** and **McIntosh County** were tied for the second highest rate for the month. **Cimarron County** claimed the lowest county unemployment rate of 1.5 percent. Unemployment rates in December were lower than a year earlier in 76 counties and higher in one county.

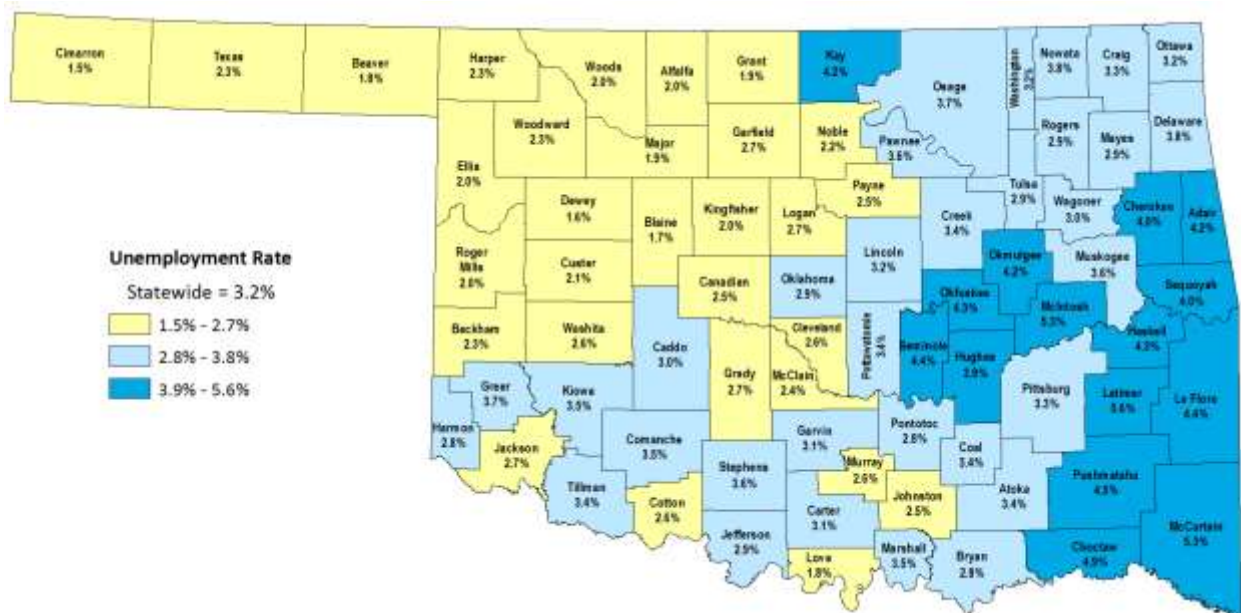
