OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT REPORT – December 2017 Metropolitan statistical area (MSA), county and other subarea information

Unemployment rates improve over the year for most Oklahoma counties in December

In December, **McIntosh County** posted Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate of 7.4 percent. **Latimer County** had the second highest rate for the month, while **McCurtain County** reported the state's third highest rate. **Woods County** claimed the lowest county unemployment rate of 2.0 percent followed by **Alfalfa, Beaver, and Cimarron Counties**. Unemployment rates were lower than a year earlier in 75 of 77 counties.


