OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT REPORT – January 2016 Metropolitan statistical area (MSA) and county information

Unemployment rates up for most Oklahoma counties in January

In January, **McIntosh County** posted Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate of 8.7 percent. **Haskell County** and **Latimer County** had the second highest rate for the month, while **McCurtain County** reported the state's third highest rate. **Cimarron County** claimed the lowest county unemployment rate of 2.3 percent. Unemployment rates increased over the month in 66 of 77 counties, while five counties saw unemployment rates decline.


