OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT REPORT – January 2020

Metropolitan statistical area (MSA), county and other subarea information

Jobless rates down over the year for most counties in Oklahoma in January

In January, **Latimer County** posted Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate of 7.3 percent. **McIntosh County** had the second-highest rate for the month, followed by **Haskell** and **McCurtain Counties**. **Cimarron County** had the lowest county unemployment rate of 1.6 percent in January. Unemployment rates in January were lower than a year earlier in 50 counties, higher in 21 counties and unchanged in 6 counties.




