OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT REPORT – April 2016

Metropolitan statistical area (MSA) and county information

Unemployment rates up over the year for most Oklahoma counties in April

In April, **Stephens County** posted Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate of 8.4 percent. **Latimer County** had the second highest rate for the month, while **McIntosh County** reported the state's third highest rate. **Cimarron County** claimed the lowest county unemployment rate of 2.2 percent. Unemployment rates were higher than a year earlier in 50 of 77 counties, lower in 19 counties, and unchanged in 8 counties.


