OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT REPORT – May 2017

Metropolitan statistical area (MSA) and county information

Unemployment rates improve over the year for most of Oklahoma counties in May

In May, **McIntosh County** posted Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate of 8.1 percent. **Haskell County** had the second highest rate for the month, while **Latimer County** and **Stephens County** reported the state's third highest rate. **Cimarron County** claimed the lowest county unemployment rate of 2.6 percent. Unemployment rates were lower than a year earlier in 65 of 77 counties, unchanged in six counties and higher in six counties.


