OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT REPORT – June 2016

Metropolitan statistical area (MSA) and county information

Unemployment rates up over the year for most Oklahoma counties in June

In June, **Stephens County** posted Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate of 10.8 percent. **Latimer County** had the second highest rate for the month, while **McIntosh County** reported the state's third highest rate. **Grant County** claimed the lowest county unemployment rate of 3.3 percent. Unemployment rates were higher than a year earlier in 65 of 77 counties, lower in 10 counties, and unchanged in 2 counties.


