## OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT REPORT – August 2018 Metropolitan statistical area (MSA), county and other subarea information

### Unemployment rates down over the year for all counties in Oklahoma in August

In August, **Latimer County** posted Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate of 6.1 percent. **McIntosh County** had the second highest rate for the month, while **McCurain County** had the state's third highest rate. **Grant County** claimed the lowest county unemployment rate of 1.8 percent followed by **Love County**, **Beaver County**, **Cimarron County**, and **Ellis County**. Unemployment rates in August were lower than a year earlier in all 77 counties.


