OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT REPORT – September 2016 Metropolitan statistical area (MSA) and county information

Unemployment rates up over the year for almost all Oklahoma counties in September

In September, **Stephens County** posted Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate of 10.4 percent. **McIntosh County** had the second highest rate for the month, while **Latimer County** reported the state's third highest rate. **Cimarron County** claimed the lowest county unemployment rate of 2.8 percent. Unemployment rates were higher than a year earlier in 76 of 77 counties and lower in one county.


