Unemployment rates down over the year for all counties in Oklahoma in October

In October, **Latimer County** posted Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate of 6.3 percent. **McIntosh County** had the second highest rate for the month, while **McCurtain County** had the state's third highest rate. **Dewey County** claimed the lowest county unemployment rate of 1.4 percent. Unemployment rates in October were lower than a year earlier in all 77 counties.

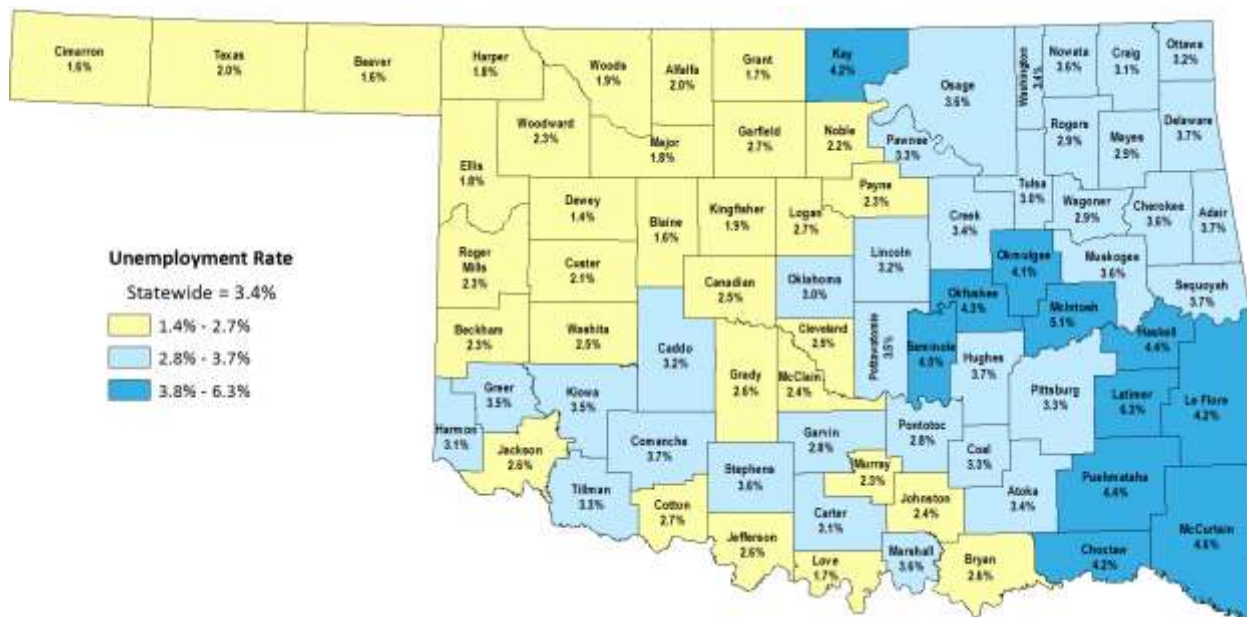
