Notice from Insulators Joint Apprenticeship Committee

The Heat & Frost Insulators Joint Apprenticeship Committee (JAC) is seeking applicants, male and female, for apprenticeship training in the commercial and industrial insulation trade. The JAC anticipates selecting one to three apprentices in the near future. All others who meet the qualifications will be maintained in a pool of eligible applicants for future work opportunities during the next two years.

Note: Apprentices receive training in commercial insulation, industrial and process plant insulation, refrigeration and low temperature insulation and prefabrication of fittings, head covers and related work.

Applications may be picked up at the Insulators and Allied Workers' Local #94 union office, 5350 S. Western, Suite 217, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Monday – Friday, Beginning Monday, November 26th, 2007 thru Friday, December 7th, 2007. Completed applications and related documents must be returned to the above address no later than 3:00 p.m. Friday, December 21st, 2007. Applicants will be selected based on highest qualifications without regard to race, color, religion, sex or national origin. Applications must be completed and returned to the Local 94 Union office by the December 21st, 2007 to be included in the interviews for February. The following items must accompany the completed application.

(Failure to submit items #1, 2 and 3 will result in automatic disqualification as an applicant)

1. Copy of your high school transcript or GED completion certificate
2. Certified copy of your birth certificate.
3. Current copy of your driving record from the Department of Public Safety.
4. Copies of transcripts of any further education you wish taken into consideration by the JAC.
5. Veterans may provide a copy of their DD 214 Military Discharge Form.

Applicants must meet the following requirements to qualify:

- ◆ Age of 18 years or over
- ◆ High School graduate or (High School Transcript Required) or proof of GED, if applicable
- ◆ US citizen or Legal resident alien (Documentation required)
- ◆ Valid drivers license to be evidenced with a current driving record
- ◆ Physical exam & drug test will be required prior to indenturement
