SUBJECT: Instructions for Disseminating Information Regarding Eligible Providers of Youth Activities

MESSAGE: In accordance with Section 123 of the Workforce Investment Act, the Local Workforce Investment Boards (LWIBs) are to identify eligible providers of youth activities by awarding grants or contracts on a competitive basis based on the recommendation of the youth council and on the criteria contained in the State plan. As one of the statewide activities listed under 20 CFR §665.200(b)(4) - the State is required to disseminate a list of eligible providers of youth activities as described in WIA §123. The State list is available through the OESC website.

ACTION: The Oklahoma Employment Security Commission (OESC) has currently compiled and updated the listing of eligible providers of youth activities based on information received from LWIBs. These providers are those that LWIBs have competitively contracted with to provide WIA youth services. In order for OESC to maintain and update this listing - LWIBs are required to submit the following information to Kim Braddy by June 30th of each year:

- Name of Youth Provider
- Mailing Address
- Physical Address
- Telephone and Fax Numbers
- Name of contact person with email address
- List of services provided

Also, the above information is required to be submitted to OESC for any new contracts awarded after June 30th.
