To Whom It May Concern:

Please be advised that applications for the **Plumbers and Pipefitters Apprenticeship Program** are available at the Training Center (5315 S. Shartel, Oklahoma City) between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Monday through Thursday and between 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 noon on Friday. Applications may be obtained in person, by mail, fax, e-mail or requested from the web site (www.plumbersandpipefitters.com).

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

- 1) Must be a minimum of **18** years old in order to be accepted into the Program. An applicant who is seventeen (17) years of age at the time of application, who otherwise meets all qualifications, may be rated, ranked and placed on the Pool of Eligibles list. Such an applicant must provide proof that a graduation certificate or GED has been awarded, and must be eighteen (18) years of age, prior to being indentured by the JATC.
- 2) Must be a high school graduate or have a GED. (Must provide a copy of high school **TRANSCRIPT** or GED scores).

The applicant must return the application, *with required documents*, before the deadline for the next interview session in order to be considered.

We anticipate accepting 10 to 15 apprentices this year. It is the policy of the Plumbers and Pipefitters Joint Apprenticeship and Training Committee (J.A.T.C.) to seek and indenture applicants into the Apprenticeship Program without regard to race, color, age, religion, sex or national origin. Both **males** and **females** are encouraged to make application.
