Enclosed is one of our brochures that describes the opportunities and basic requirements of our 2011 Electrical Apprentice Training Program. The information contained in the brochure has been updated to meet the latest U. S. Department of Labor Regulations.

The recruitment, selection, employment and training of apprentices during their apprenticeship, shall be without discrimination because of race, color, religion, national origin, sex or age-except the applicant must be at least 17 years of age to apply and 18 years of age at the time of indenture. High school seniors may apply for the program prior to their graduation, but will not be allowed to enter the program until after graduation if selected. The JATC does not, and will not, discriminate against a qualified individual with a disability because of the disability of such individual. Both males and females are encouraged to make application.

The program anticipates selecting 10 or more apprentices this year. The JATC will make applications available daily between hours of 8:00 AM and 3:00 PM on normal business hours and Mondays from 6:00 PM to 7:00 PM.
