## OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT REPORT - November 2010 Metropolitan statistical area (MSA) and county information

### Many counties see unemployment rate drops in November

**McCurtain County** again claimed Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate of 10.6 percent in November 2010. **Latimer and Hughes counties** rounded out the three highest county rates for the month. **Beaver County** reported the state's lowest county unemployment rate. Forty-nine of Oklahoma's 77 counties recorded unemployment rate decreases in November.


