At 11.8 percent, **McCurtain County** once again recorded Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate in November 2009. **Hughes and Latimer counties** rounded out the three highest county rates for the month. **Beaver County** again posted the state's lowest county rate at 3.3 percent. **Cimarron County** held the state's second lowest county rate, and **Harper County** claimed the third lowest county rate in November.


