## OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT REPORT - December 2011

Metropolitan statistical area (MSA) and county information

### Latimer County ends year with Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate

In December 2011, **Latimer County** posted the state's highest county unemployment rate at 10.5 percent. **Hughes County** claimed the state's second highest county rate, and **McCurtain County** accounted for the third highest monthly rate. **Roger Mills County** reported Oklahoma's lowest county rate in December. For the month, 57 of Oklahoma's 77 counties, or nearly three-quarters, reported unemployment rate increases.


