Metropolitan statistical area (MSA) and county information

### McCurtain County ends 2009 with highest county unemployment rate in state

At 11.9 percent in December, **McCurtain County** once again held Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate for the month. **Hughes and Latimer counties** rounded out the three highest county rates for December. **Beaver County** reported the state's lowest county rate at 3.1 percent. **Cimarron County** claimed the state's second lowest county rate, and **Woods County** recorded December's third lowest county rate.


