### Latimer County closes 2010 with state's highest county unemployment rate

Latimer County provided Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate of 10.7 percent in December 2010. McCurtain and Hughes counties rounded out the three highest county rates for the month. Beaver County again reported the state's lowest county unemployment rate. Nearly half of Oklahoma's 77 counties saw their unemployment rates drop in December.


