## OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT REPORT - January 2011 Metropolitan statistical area (MSA) and county information

### Latimer County reports highest county unemployment rate in January 2011

Latimer County opened the year with Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate of 11.7 percent in January 2011. **McCurtain and Okmulgee counties** rounded out the three highest county rates for the month. **Beaver and Roger Mills counties** tied for the state's lowest January rate at 3.5 percent. Just over three-quarters of Oklahoma's 77 counties saw their unemployment rates rise in January 2011.


