OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT REPORT - January 2010

Metropolitan statistical area (MSA) and county information

McCurtain County opens the year with Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate

McCurtain County reported a January 2010 unemployment rate of 12.1 percent, the highest in Oklahoma for the month. Latimer and Sequoyah counties rounded out the three highest county rates in January. Beaver County reported the state's lowest county rate at 3.4 percent. Harper and Woods counties shared the state's second lowest rate of 4.2 percent, while Cimarron County claimed the state's third lowest county rate of 4.4 percent.


