Most counties report slight change in unemployment rate for January

Latimer County opened 2014 with the state's highest county unemployment rate of 9.4 percent. McCurtain County and Sequoyah County contributed the second and third highest rates for the month. Dewey County provided January's lowest county unemployment rate of 2.6 percent. Rates for 15 of Oklahoma's 77 counties remained unchanged over the month.


