Metropolitan statistical area (MSA) and county information

Latimer County records Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate in February 2011

Latimer County retained Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate in February 2011, coming in at 12.3 percent for the month. **McCurtain and Okmulgee counties** rounded out the three highest county rates for February. **Roger Mills County** claimed the state's lowest February rate of 3.5 percent. Just over three-quarters of Oklahoma's 77 counties saw either no change or an unemployment rate decrease in February 2011.


