## OKLAHOMA EMPLOYMENT REPORT - February 2010

Metropolitan statistical area (MSA) and county information

### Sequoyah County reports state's highest county unemployment rate in February

At 12.0 percent for the month, **Sequoyah County** claimed Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate in February 2010. **Latimer and McCurtain counties** rounded out the three highest county rates for February. **Beaver County** again reported the state's lowest county rate at 3.5 percent. **Harper County** held the state's second lowest county rate, and **Woods County** recorded the month's third lowest county rate.


