Latimer County posts highest county unemployment rate for April 2011

Latimer County reported Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate of 8.4 percent in April 2011. Okmulgee County claimed the state's second highest rate, and McCurtain County posted the third highest rate for the month. Roger Mills County accounted for the state's lowest April rate of 2.3 percent. For the second straight month, all 77 Oklahoma counties saw improvement in their unemployment rates in April.


