Latimer and McCurtain counties share state's highest county unemployment rate in May

Latimer County and McCurtain County tied for Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate (8.5 percent) in May 2011. Okmulgee County posted the state's second highest rate, and LeFlore County claimed the third highest rate for the month. Roger Mills County reported the state's lowest May rate of 2.6 percent. In May, unemployment rates in 68 of Oklahoma's 77 Oklahoma counties increased over the month.


