In May 2010, **Latimer County** reported the state's highest county unemployment rate of 10.7 percent. **McCurtain County** posted the state's second highest rate, as **Hughes County** claimed the third highest county rate. **Beaver County** again recorded the state's lowest county rate at 3.5 percent for the month. **Harper County** and **Dewey County** rounded out May's three lowest county rates.


