Unemployment rates up for most Oklahoma counties in June

Latimer County reported the state's highest county unemployment rate of 8.5 percent in June 2014. **McCurtain County** and **McIntosh County** provided the second and third highest county rates, respectively. Oklahoma's lowest county unemployment rate of 2.7 percent was posted by **Beckham County**. Unemployment rates rose over the month in 72 of 77 Oklahoma counties.


