Latimer County claimed Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate at 9.7 percent in July 2011. LeFlore and McCurtain counties shared the second highest county rate, while Hughes County reported the third highest rate for the month. Roger Mills County recorded the state's lowest county rate. In July, unemployment rates dropped over the month in 72 of Oklahoma's 77 counties.


